The TCNJ Center for Global Engagement offers qualified students the opportunity to study at educational institutions abroad and on campuses in the United States, its territories, and in Canada. TCNJ students can study for an academic year, a semester, or the summer. With careful planning, students who study off-campus should expect to make normal progress toward graduation.

All programs offered by TCNJ are pre-approved by the faculty, and credits are transferable and applicable to specific degree requirements. Declared students from all majors are encouraged to apply. Instruction is in English at many participating institutions abroad. TCNJ also encourages students to study languages in non-English-speaking countries. Language classes are offered at beginning, intermediate and advanced levels.

Study abroad applications should be submitted to the TCNJ Center for Global Engagement (Roscoe West 202) by late February for the following summer, fall semester, or entire year; applications are due in late September for the following spring semester. National Student Exchange (NSE) applications are due in February of the year preceding participation. Selection for off-campus study is competitive, and students are selected on the basis of their academic qualifications, references, and potential for success. Most TCNJ students, however, have been accepted by their preferred off-campus and study abroad programs.

Depending upon the program, students may be able to study off campus for approximately the same amount of money as it would cost to study at TCNJ. However, some international programs may cost more. All quoted program prices are approximate and subject to change each year. Most students receiving financial aid may apply those funds to their program costs, although there are some exceptions. Students planning to study off campus should anticipate paying for their travel, books, and personal spending money. In addition, students going abroad must pay for their passports, any required visas, and international insurance.

### TCNJ Faculty-led Programs Abroad

TCNJ faculty step outside the walls of the classroom and lead groups of students abroad to teach their courses in a variety of locations. Some courses are offered in the winter or summer and last for 3-4 weeks. Other courses are taught on-campus with one or two weeks spent in another country as part of the course requirement. Students need to submit applications to the TCNJ Center for Global Engagement in the fall semester. Courses and locations will vary each year.

### Programs Sponsored by The College of New Jersey

The College of New Jersey has established relationships with the institutions listed below for students to study abroad. Programs listed as “exchanges” allow students to pay their normal TCNJ tuition for the semester or year, use their entire financial aid and scholarship package, and study abroad, while “direct” program students pay only a program fee set by the host institution. Recently TCNJ has created several “study centers,” allowing students to use all financial aid and scholarship awards to pay for their study abroad experiences.
