 - d. IMM 251 Audio Recording and Production
 - e. Topics course by advisement
- **5.** One of the following:
 - a. JPW 308 Media Law/COM 210 Mass Media and the First Amendment (crosslisted)
 - b. JPW 309 Media Ethics

In accordance with existing College policy, at least half of the courses required for the minor must be completed at TCNJ or through a prior approved course exchange program. In addition, in accordance with College policy, at least two of the courses must be 300-level or above. Only one course unit, either required or elective, may be used to satisfy requirements for both a major field and a minor field.
