

Broadcast and Multimedia Journalism Minor

The interdisciplinary minor in Broadcast and Multimedia Journalism requires a total of five units, in five categories as follows, with students taking one course from each:

 - e. AAV 230 Photo II: Documentary Photo
 - f. AAV 244 Video I
 - g. AAV 330 Photo III: Image and Narrative
 - h. Topics course by advisement
4. One of the following audio-related choices:
 - a. COM 269 Intro to Audio Production
 - b. COM 369 Advanced Radio and Audio Production
 - c. JPW 370 Topics in Journalism: Podcasting
 - d. IMM 251/MUS 337 Audio Recording and
 - e. Topics course by advisement
5. One of the following:
 - a. JPW 308 Media Law/COM 210 Mass Media and the First Amendment (cross-listed)
 - b. JPW 309 Media Ethics

In accordance with existing College policy, at least half of the courses required for the minor must be completed at TCNJ or through a prior approved course exchange program. In addition, in accordance with College policy, at least two of the courses must be 300-level or above. Only one course unit, either required or elective, may be used to satisfy requirements for both a major field and a minor field.
