Speech Pathology and Audiology Minor

The Speech Pathology and Audiology Minor provides the prerequisites necessary to prepare students for graduate study in speech-language pathology or audiology. The program consists of five courses, considered by the accrediting agency, the American Speech-Language-Hearing Association (ASHA), as essential to students seeking admission to graduate programs in the field. Only one course taken as a part of a student's major may be counted toward the student's minor.
